




Sketchbook Communications: art books



What does the reflection of who we are and what we do by the sea tell us about ourselves? What is it about us that stays and leaves in what comes and goes in the margins of the shore ? Can this line, or margin, that we draw, question and respond to be opened up to heal and better respond to who we are when time and space, and the life it sustains, inverts and fades ? How do we illustrate this dialogue to find our own poem along the shore.

If we take enough pictures on a question, the answers may eventually begin to take shape on the screen.
